Aive HOUSE RULES

- * The Ticket grants the Visitor the right to access the Event upon presentation of a valid and undamaged Ticket together with valid identification. The Organizer guarantees the validity of the Ticket only if it has been purchased directly from the Organizer or from a sales outlet recognized by the Organizer. If the Visitor leaves the Event or the Event location after admission, the Ticket automatically loses its validity.
- * The Visitor is not permitted to resell the Ticket and/or to offer it to third parties with the intention of making a profit.
- * The Ticket grants access to the Event only to Visitors over the age of 18. The Organizer will deny access to the Event to persons under the age of 18, without being obliged to refund the ticket price.
- * The Organizer is exclusively entitled to designate a platform for the resale of Tickets for the Event. Resale of Tickets via any channel other than those designated by the Organizer is prohibited. Visitors holding a Ticket obtained through an unauthorized source may be refused entry to the Event. The Organizer cannot be held liable for any loss or damage resulting from the purchase or sale of a Ticket (including the validity of a Ticket) for the Event via a sales channel not designated by the Organizer.
- * The Organizer has the right to search the Visitor, or the Visitor is obliged to submit to a search, before and/or during entry to the Event.

- * It is prohibited to possess or bring into the Event cameras, spray cans, aerosols, selfie sticks, glassware, plastic bottles, cans, (alcoholic) beverages, food, drugs, nitrous oxide, flammable substances, fireworks, (fire)arms and/or other dangerous items. The Organizer has the right to confiscate such items. Confiscated items will not be returned but will be destroyed by the Organizer and/or a third party designated by the Organizer.
- * The Visitor is obliged to comply with the (safety) regulations (including the house rules) and/or the instructions of the Organizer and other authorized personnel. The Visitor is not permitted to harass and/or hinder other visitors or staff present at the Event. The Visitor is also not permitted to be in a state of public intoxication and/or under the influence of drugs during the Event and/or at the Event location, nor to urinate outside the designated toilet facilities. Climbing onto or into objects is prohibited. If a smoking ban is in force at the Event location, this ban applies to all tobacco products.
- * The Organizer has the right to record the Event, including the right to make or have made image and/or sound recordings of the Event and its Visitors.
- * Recording of the Event in any form whatsoever, including photographing, filming and making sound and/or image recordings, is not permitted without the Organizer's prior written consent.

- * The Organizer will strive to ensure that the Event takes place as much as possible in accordance with the announced schedule and line-up. However, the Organizer accepts no liability for deviations. The starting time stated on the Ticket is subject to change. The Organizer accepts no liability regarding the manner of performance by the artists or the duration of their performances.
- * Tokens purchased during the Event are valid only during the Event. Purchased tokens cannot be exchanged or refunded.
- * The Organizer accepts no liability for hearing damage, visual impairment, blindness or other physical injury, or for damage to property, whether or not caused by other Visitors of the Event. The Organizer expressly advises Visitors to wear hearing protection during the Event.
- * In the case of force majeure, the Organizer shall have the right to reschedule the Event to another date or to cancel it.
- * The Visitor is obliged to report any damage within 48 hours after the end of the Event to the Organizer via info@aldalive.com, failing which any right to compensation shall lapse.
- * The Visitor is obliged to report complaints within 30 days after the end of the Event to the Organizer via info@alive-events.nl, failing which any right to any form of compensation shall lapse.

- * Attendance at the Event is at the Visitor's own risk.
- * If the Visitor breaches one or more of the provisions of these House Rules and/or if the Organizer deems this necessary at its sole discretion in order to maintain public order and safety during the Event, the Organizer is entitled to invalidate the Ticket, deny the Visitor (further) access to the Event, remove the Visitor from the Event location, hand the Visitor over to the police and/or claim compensation for any damages incurred or to be incurred. This also applies to a Visitor wearing clothing, texts or other expressions which, in the opinion of the Organizer, are offensive, discriminatory or insulting, or which may otherwise lead to unrest or aggression. This includes, but is not limited to, clothing of football clubs or motorcycle clubs and clothing bearing political statements.
